Man (standing) is John Brown Jr. who was born in Gympie 1887; man (sitting) is John Brown Sr. who was born in Manchester 1862. Of the two remaining men, one is William Brown who was born in Gympie 1885 and the other man is unidentified. (Description supplied with photograph). The men are photographed at the headworks of the mine. John Brown Jr holds the handle of the windlass which mounted on a log platform at the head of the shaft. Various pieces of hand mining equipment, a pile of rock and a sieve are seen near the mine entrance. Stannary Hills was a tin-mining town in the Herberton minerals area, 30 km west of Atherton and 12 km north of Irvinebank.
