Tom Kenyon
South Australian Government

Tom Kenyon began his working life on a cattle station in QLD before going to university in his home town of Adelaide attaining an Arts degree in Asian Studies and an applied science degree in Environmental Management.

He was intimately involved in the creation of the PACE initiative in SA and together with Paul Holloway, began lobbying for a change in the ALP's "no new uranium mines" policy. He was elected to parliament in the 2006 state election for the seat of Newland. In his maiden speech, he called for the removal of the ALP's uranium policy. In between electorate functions, he tries to keep his hand in with the resources sector and frequently represents Paul Holloway at resource industry events.
